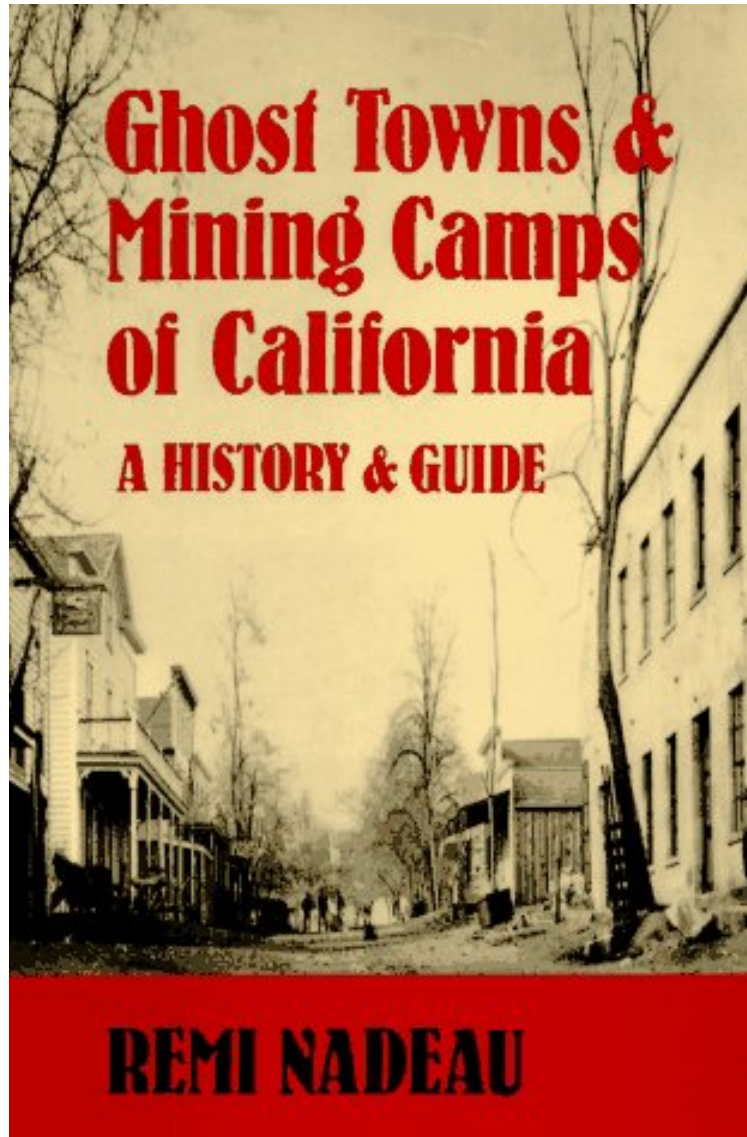

Unfortunately, the author and I have VERY different definitions of the term "ghost town". This book features mostly currently populated towns that are in touristy areas and are all easily accessible by highways. These are historic towns, with lots of old buildings and cool stuff to check out--

but these are NOT "ghost towns". IMO, a ghost town is mostly or completely abandoned with no population, and are generally off the beaten path. There should be old buildings and relics and cemeteries and interesting history stories to be found, but not people, gas stations, pizza joints, and modern houses.
