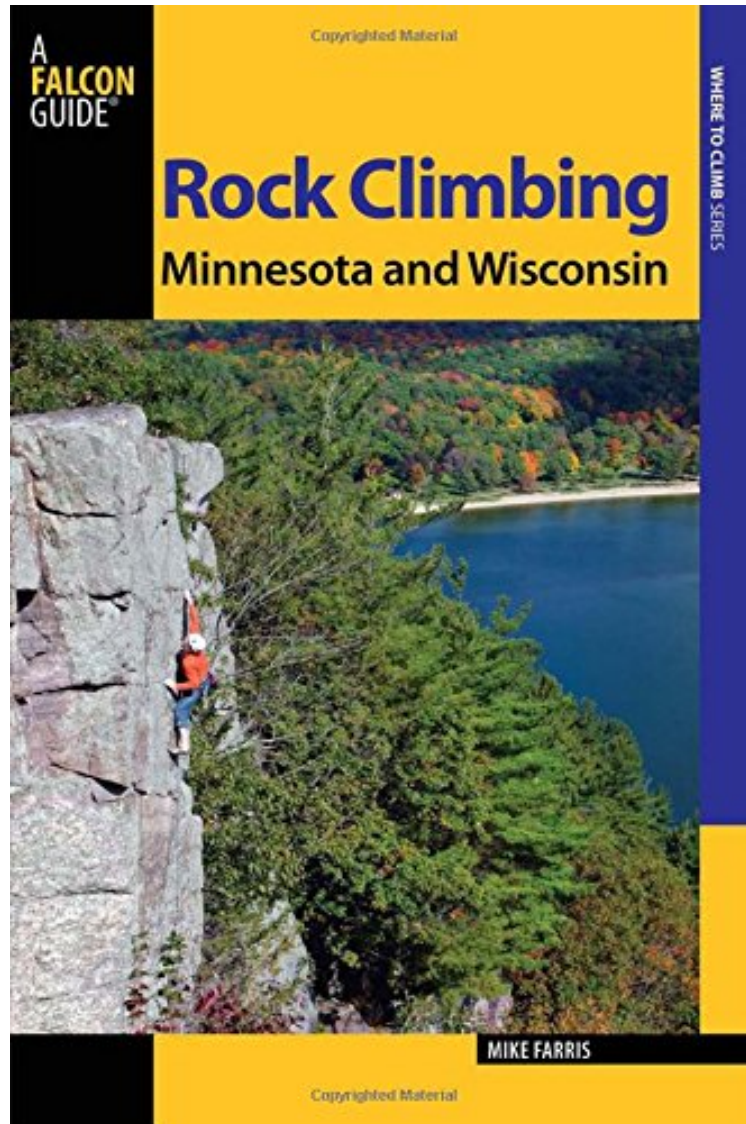

It also describes local ethics while at each location in order for climbers to maintain a good relationship with the public and park staff so that we can continue to use the cliffs required for our sport.
