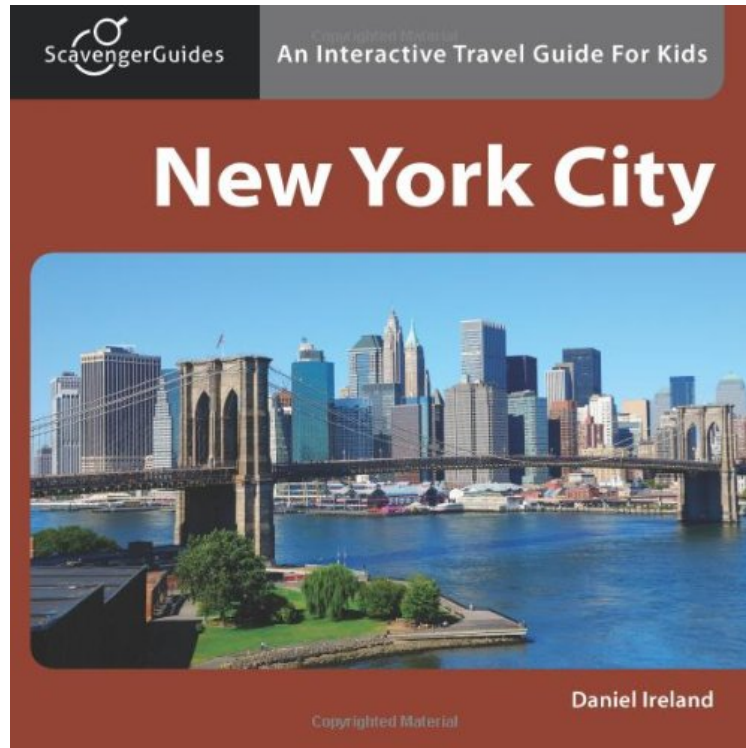

There are some fun facts about NYC but if typed out, the content in this book would probably fit on about 10 letter size pages. Much of this book contains groups of blank pages for "notes." Some blank pages are lined and some are blank, some are blank achievement certificates, there are blank lines for answers throughout much of the text as well. It really seems like a lot of effort was put into padding this book out. If I wanted a notebook for my kids to write in, I would have bought something more cute and portable for them to carry around. The photos are poor quality. They are amateur snapshot style photos that appear to have been photocopied into the book. They are black and white with streaks across them like you'd get in a photocopier or fax machine. I thought this would be more of a guidebook for kids which I would have liked. Instead, it is more of a scavenger hunt check list, which would be fine too. However, for the price I would have expected more content and a more professional presentation with quality images that make it fun for kids to browse etc...
