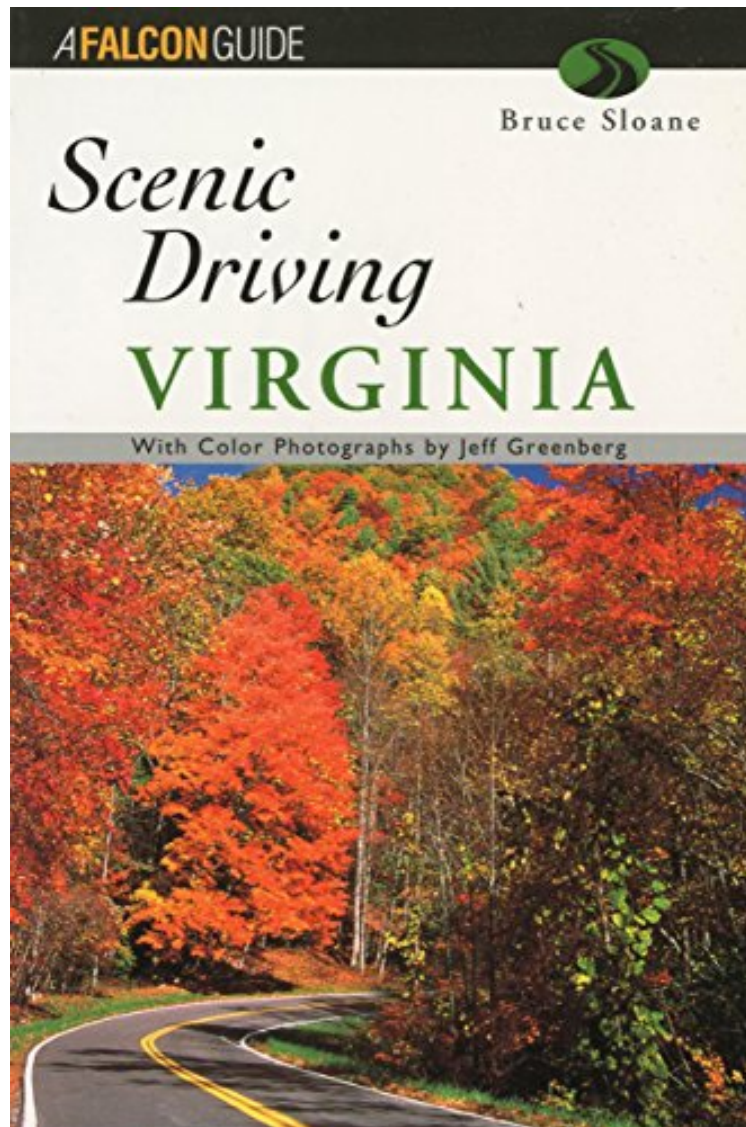

I've lived in Virginia on and off for 19 years since 1977 and wish I'd found this book earlier. But not a 5-star review: (1) The repro for the photos is pretty grim. And it would help if whoever set up the shots for the book knew

how to keep the photos "level".(2) This is a guidebook. The next time it gets updated and/or printed, do us a favor -- print the directions in bold face. Directions are distributed through the narrative paragraphs in the same type face and it is difficult to "pull" them out of the text. I was trying to pre-mark a map and the task was more difficult than it needed to be.
