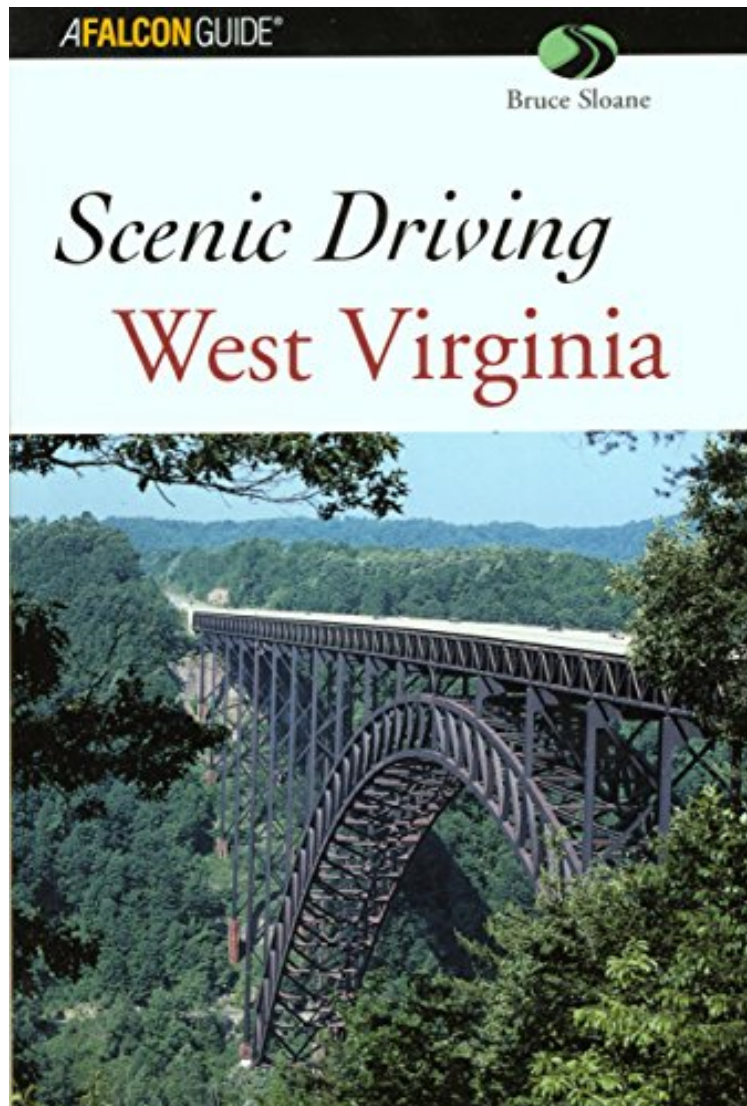

The tours themselves are quite good, meaning that they are sure to engage travelers with interests in geography and history.The real problems with this guide are about content AND format. First, the content. There are few details about the sites and locations included with each tour. Actually, each of the 24 tours included in the book gets about three summary pages. On top of that, there are no listings for

lodging or dining included at all. Zip. Nada. The brief descriptions included with the tours offer driving directions, but few historical or cultural contexts. Those of you planning trips in and around the two largest cities - Charleston and Huntington - will be disappointed. Those places get barely a mention. Second, the format. The editing here is just plain sloppy. There are many spelling errors. There are duplicate photographs with different captions. There are photographs with captions that are just plain wrong, such as the one supposedly showing the Pearl Buck house. Use this guide PURELY for the purpose of planning a day-trip route, because it's not particularly useful as a learning tool or for an armchair trip. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
