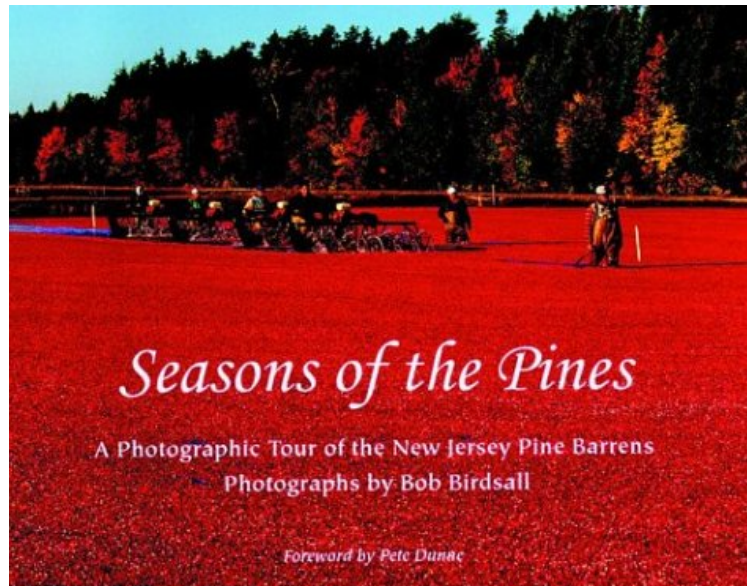

In *Seasons of the Pines*, nature photographer Bob Birdsall unveils the wonders of the wildlife, plant life, and landscape that make up this little-known natural area, designated Americas first National Reserve in 1978. From the cranberry bogs and cedar streams to the pygmy pines and deep forests, this photo album depicts it all in glorious color. Many of the wildlife and plant species shown here are designated endangered or threatened and are found only in the New Jersey Pine Barrens or isolated pockets elsewhere. Birdsalls remarkable portrayal of this unique landscape focuses our attention on the states rapidly diminishing green spaces, and reminds us of the necessity of preserving these areas for future generations.
