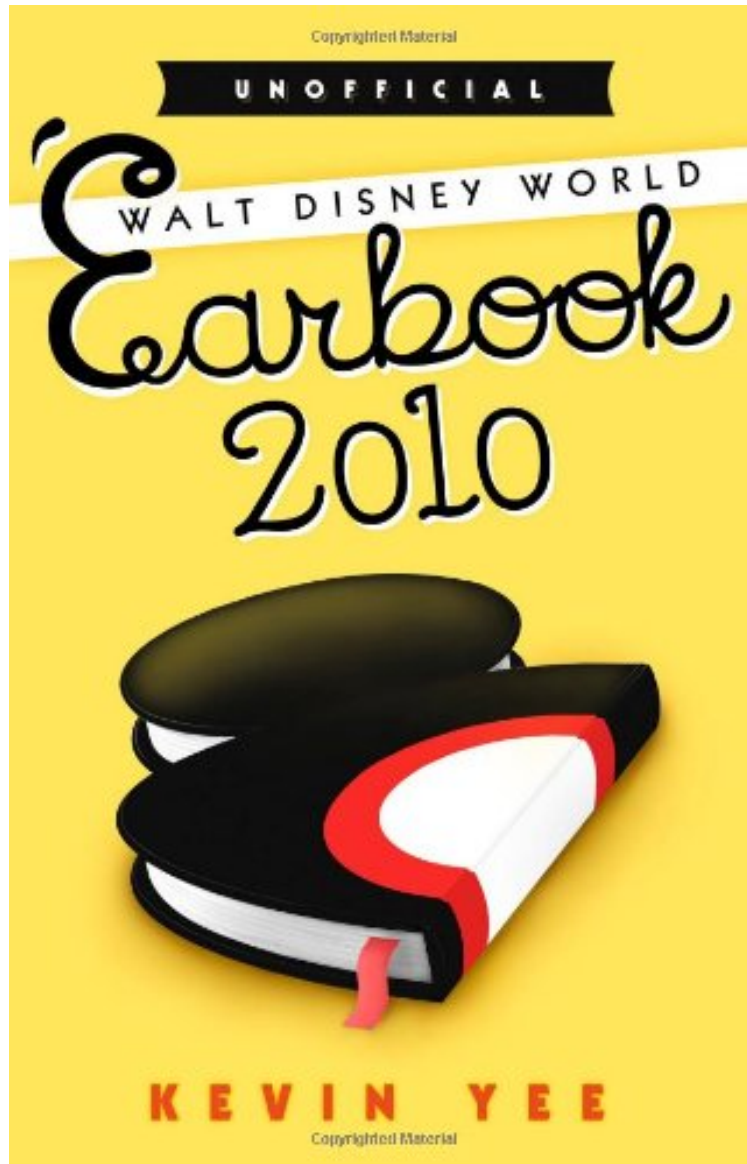

first: this book looks like someone who had an annual pass and a love for Disney and a lot of time on their hands could have produced. There isn't amazing page layout, there is a tremendous amount of white space on a page, the font used is uninteresting, and it almost looks like he might have created this on Word and the publisher took the pages and printed them in this book. Appearance wise, the book suffers. My biggest fear in receiving the books was that it was kind of small and thin. Ok, that turned out to be nothing to worry about because this really is a nice book to have in any WDW fan's collection, as it is both comprehensive and accessible. Yee details all the major changes (I'm sure there are some minor things like paint color differences that a picky fan might think of) that occurred in 2010. He uses pictures effectively to demonstrate the changes (I wish there had been a few before/after shots, as over the years we might forget the before). His book doesn't stop in the parks, but extends to the entirety of WDW. The written sections help explain the changes - completed, in progress and recently announced - and help a reader to understand what might not be conveyed in an image on the page. In summary, this is a nice addition to your library. I do think the 2011 version at this time is overpriced at 24.99, but the 2010 is a much better price (15.72 at this writing). I hope that Yee continues to publish the books, perhaps with a little more work by the publisher to make the pages look more professional, and a better price point for the new books. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. From the closing of Star Tours and "Honey, I Shrunk the Audience" to the debut of several new experiences, 2010 held a lot of change for Walt Disney World. Additions included Summer Nightstastic, Captain EO, Main Street Electrical Parade, Duffy the Disney Bear, Via Napoli, Best Friends Pet Care, D-Street, and Pollo Campero, among others. This book captures all the new attractions in pictures, and offers brief retrospectives for the closures. Many special events are also captured here--all through the eyes of one frequent visitor. A time line of events throughout the year puts the changes into perspective, and offers a glimpse into the ever-shifting kaleidoscope that is Walt Disney World. To aid in this book's value as a reference work in the years to come, a listing of some key prices from 2010 is included, and an index makes finding each entry a snap.
