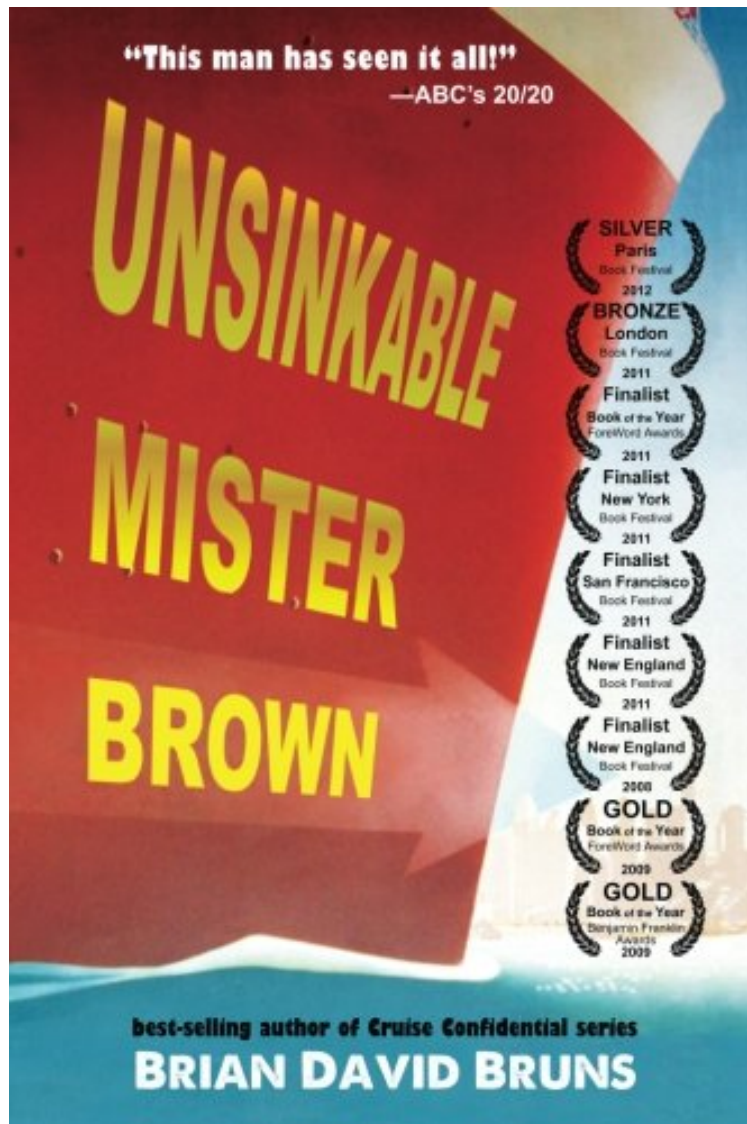

In this book we finally get to know Biana, the woman he joined Carnival Cruise for, as the only American Food Server, worked ridiculously hard and long hours for, trained to be a Ship Auctioneer, traveled around the world for, putting his life outside "cruise life" on hold, all in hopes to be with the love of his life. Biana is from Romania, who works on cruise ships to help support her family. In this book, Mr. Bruns does not focus so much on ship life and the auction training as he did in the first two books.
