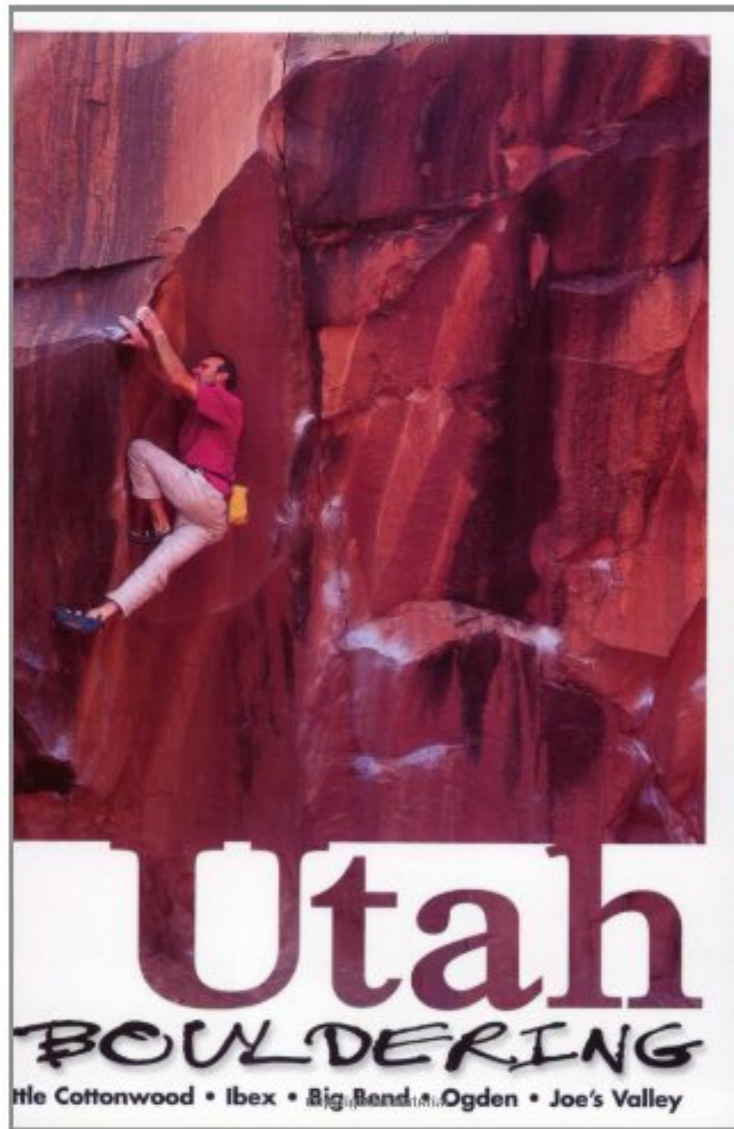

The descriptions are great, they include how to get there but also include a description of the start holds which is very handy for reassuring yourself you are on the right problem. All the

boulders are drawn with very few pictures which would seem like a negative but the attention to detail is amazing. Spatially the boulders are oriented perfectly and all the necessary aretes and corners are drawn in to help you find the boulder you are looking for. There are a few missing problems and areas in LCC, mostly, it's incorrect info on approaches. If you're interested in this guide book, I have 2 copies that I could sell for loads cheaper, and I also believe that about 80% of the climbing stores here still carry that book.
