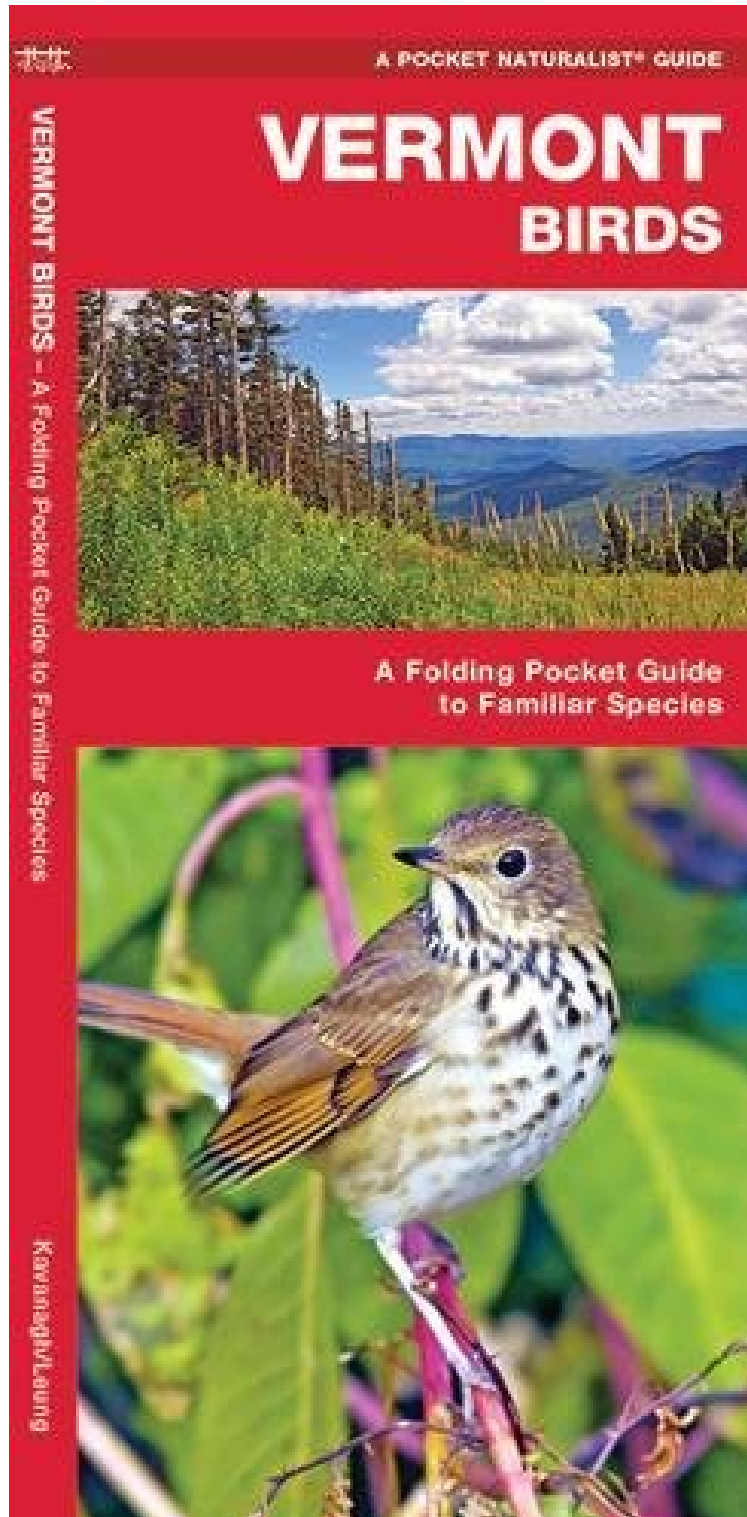

By C. Luc Reid This isn't a book, as another reviewer has noted: it's a laminated, fold-out reference of Vermont birds, entirely in color. What it's useful for to us is to be able to quickly and easily compare a bird we see to the pictures to find its name. This is a lot harder in detailed bird guides because it's necessary to flip through many pages. The illustrations are good and this is otherwise well put together. We bought one as a present for my mother and liked it enough to buy a second one for ourselves. There is no detailed information about birds in it: we use our other bird guide for that. It's not absolutely comprehensive. For instance, we couldn't find saw whet owls on it. However, it has a very good range of Vermont birds, and we expect to get a lot of use out of it.
