Despite its date there are many of these locations still operating.A general map in the beginning shows the site in the state of each place. There are 50, each with a black and white line drawing and a detailed description of the history and the food. Each restaurant has 2 or more recipes. Addresses, opening times and phone numbers are given. That information, of course should be checked before you venture out. There is an index for the recipesThe recipes themselves are not always the easiest, but a determined cook would be able to complete them. Of course one must have a ready supply of seafood since that is a big component of Virginia's cooking.We have tried several and enjoyed the results for; King's Court Tavern's London Broil, LaPetite Auberge's Backfin Crab Norfolk and that same restaurant's baked sausage.The restaurants cover all parts of the state, not just the normal tourist spots, which of course are included. Williamsburg has 4 of the 50 listed.History lovers and lovers of good food, and cookbook collectors would all like this book whether they can visit these restaurants or not, even better if you will be in the state of Virginia.
