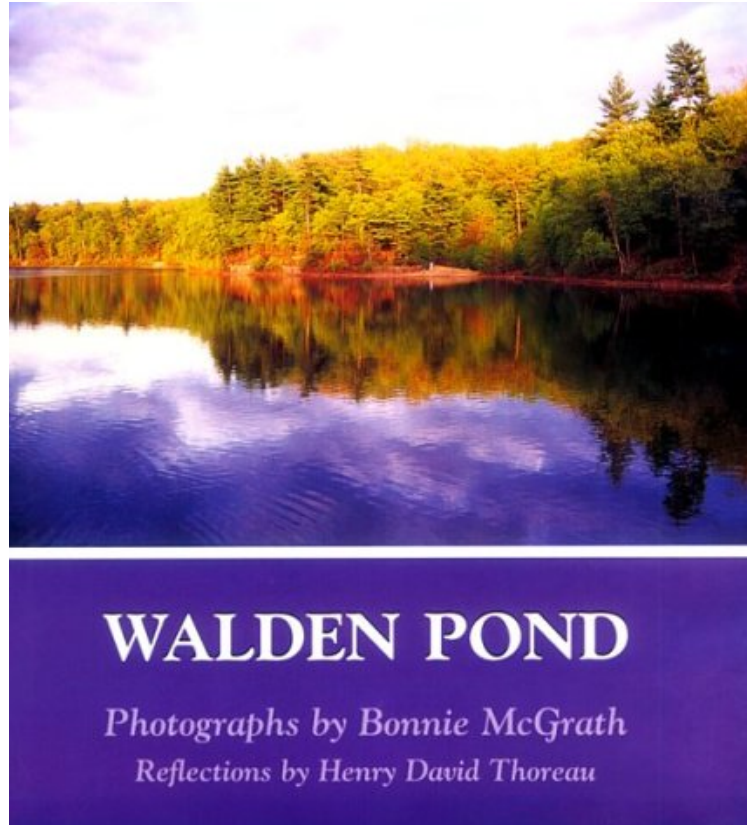

A photographer and environmentalist, McGrath has captured Walden in all seasons and moods. Her beautiful color images are matched with quotations from Thoreau's Walden, so that the reader can stand in the writer's shoes and see what he saw when he experienced Life in the Woods.

At the height of a hot summer's day its beach is alive with families at play. For those inspired by the life and thought of Henry David Thoreau, Walden Pond is steeped in history and soul.
