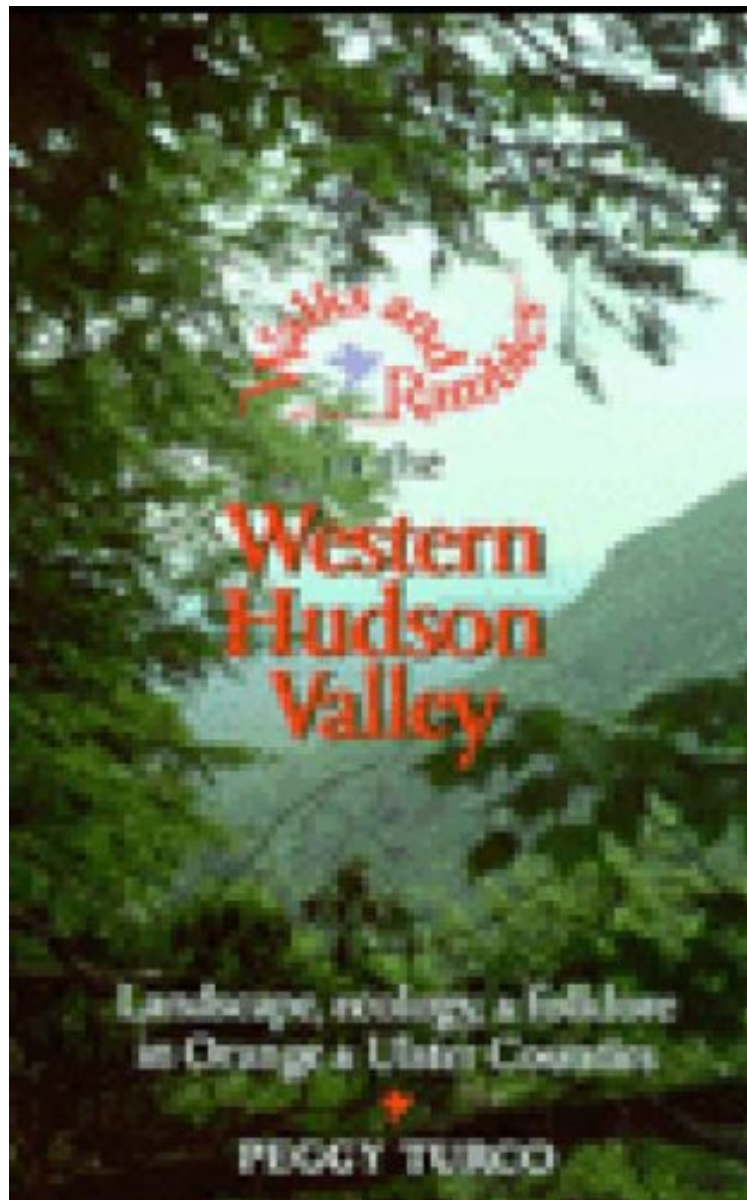

Thirty-eight walks—ranging in length from less than a mile to 10 miles in New York State's Orange and Ulster Counties—are described here in detail. Included are: Directions for driving to each trailhead A complete description and clear map of your route Information on the geology, wildlife, features, and folklore around you 31 other recommended trails in the region

Anyone who is curious about the outdoors, or who seeks quiet or closeness to the landscape will find *Walks And Rambles In The Western Hudson Valley* a useful companion. The 38 walks described in detail range from a quarter mile to ten miles in length, and also include a range of difficulties, some wandering on gentle paths and others scrambling up the sides of mountains. The last chapter suggests 31 additional trails and parks for walkers to enjoy.
