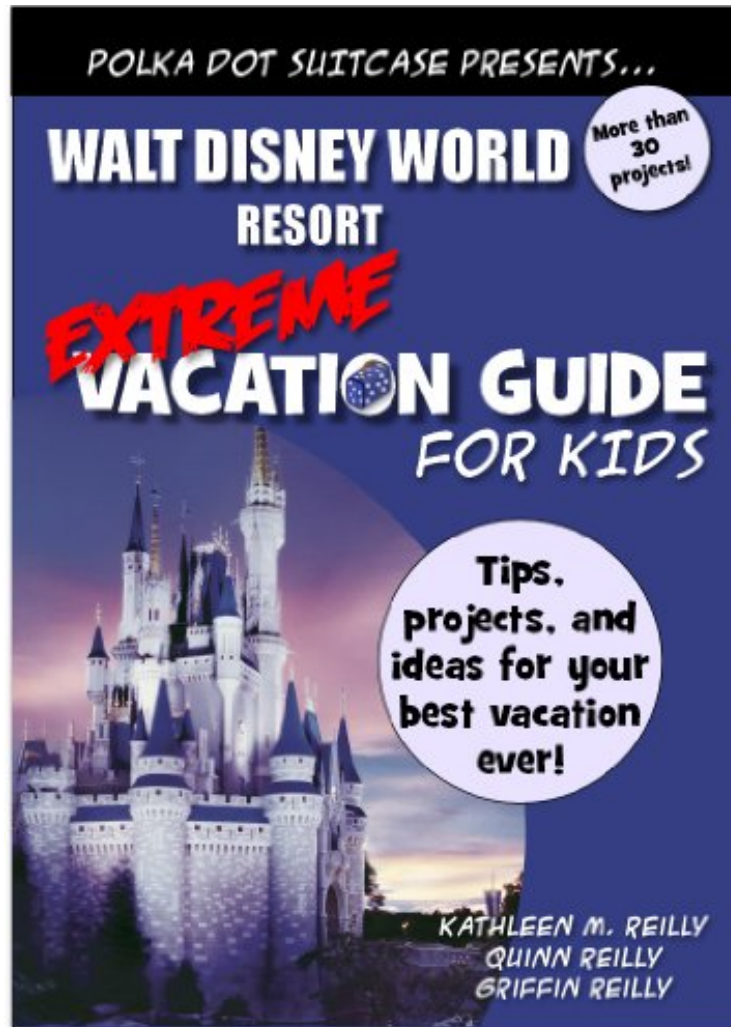

Make a trading tote (for trading pins), an autograph book, a magic towel that transforms into a tote for visiting the water parks, or a water bottle tote. Or delve into the science of Disney with science projects that explore animation, hydroponics, fiber optics, and magnetism.The added value is that kids who are

antsy about their vacation ("How many more days, Mom??") will be occupied with these activities, giving mom and dad the chance to do the necessary preparations with fewer distractions. Once you're on the road, there are games to play (no backseat bickering!) and then the author walks young readers through the different areas of the park, making note of the must-see attractions. The final section includes a collection of projects that kids can do to preserve their Disney memories. This book, written for kids, is a terrific way to involve them in that process. Not only does it help them know what to expect from a trip to Disney, but it also gives them fun activities to do as they anticipate the trip's arrival date. The projects are easily adaptable for kids of different skills and ages.
